2018-19 JUNIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS - POINT SCORE

In each age group (with exception of U6 and U7) the Club Championships will be run for both genders. There will be an overall Male and Female Club Age Champion for each age group. There will also be a Junior (11, 12 yrs combined) and Senior (13, 14 yrs combined) Male and Female Iron Person. The combined points awarded from Beach, Water and Iron Person will count towards the overall champion for each Age Group.

To be eligible to be a Club Champion, a Member must have attended and participated in:

- At least 8 "normal" Nipper days at North Avoca Beach up to and including NA Club Championship Day; (inclusive of SLSCC Interclub carnivals, NASLSC and SLSCC development camps and representative teams where these events fall on a normal nipper Sunday) plus
- Attended the North Avoca Club Championship Day; plus
- Completed the Surf Education Award prior to 31st December of the Nipper Season; and
- Completed the proficiency prior to the event for which they receive points.

Age Champion Points System

Each eligible nipper will be awarded points for their placing achieved at Club Champs. This will include points for;

Beach Sprint

Flags

Swim

Board

Iron Person (U11 years and over, awarded for place in individual age category)

Nippers who are not eligible for Club Champs can still participate in events, with the exception of Flags. Points will NOT be awarded. Those eligible nippers finishing behind a non eligible nipper will have their position elevated accordingly.

Junior and Senior Iron Person

The Junior and Senior Iron Person will be allocated based on the following;

Junior – first nipper over the line in the 11 and 12 year age categories combined Senior – First nipper over the line in the 13 and 14 year age category combined

Subject to a Member being eligible, points shall be awarded as follows:

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Overall Place in FINAL Points (Beach and Water, including the Iron Person)

1st	10 points
2nd	9 points
3rd	8 points
4th	7 points
5th	6 points
6th	5 points
7th	4 points
8th	3 points
9th	2 points
10th onwards	1 point

Did Not Finish (DNF): if a GENUINE attempt to complete the course has been made than the participant/s will be allocated 1 point. Examples of a Genuine Attempt is: Swimming to the buoy but unable to return to shore; in the

board attempting to get out through the shore break but unable to do so or exceeds reasonable time limit. Putting any part of your body into the surf and returning directly back to shore DOES NOT constitute a genuine attempt.

Genuine attempts and point allocation will be decided by the Referee or allocated official of the event.

NON-Genuine attempts will have no points recorded for Club Champions. Disqualified (DSQ) and Did Not Start (DNS) will have NIL points.

Water Safety

In the event a nipper requires assistance from water safety during a Club Championship event. The nipper must request assistance (3) times prior to water safety intervening (in the event of an emergency, water safety will make a discretionary call based on the wellbeing and safety of the nipper).

Water safety or any other bystander, Age Manager or parent may not intervene with the race, board or any other element.
